

GET READY, MICHIGAN: THEY'RE COMING

FOR YOUR JOBS, PAYCHECK AND UNION



For 30 years, U.S. workers have endured job outsourcing and privatization and falling pay, benefits, and hours. Now some politicians in Michigan's legislature want to make it even worse. So get ready to fight for your job, your paycheck and your union. Here's what's coming:

- **"Right to work"** for less. Contrary to the lies, this legislation won't give anyone rights or jobs. It just weakens unions by letting free-riders get all the benefits of union protection without paying their fair share. The result? Workers in states with these misnamed laws make \$5,500 a year less. Can you afford that?

- **Attacks on public employees.** Teachers, firefighters, federal workers and all public servants have become scapegoats for the extremists who want to shrink

government regardless of the cost in jobs and public services. They're coming at public employees with attacks on jobs, pensions and their bargaining rights.

- **Repeal of MIOSHA.** The Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act has been keeping Michigan workers safer on the job since 1974. There is a proposal in the Michigan Legislature to completely repeal MIOSHA, whose work has helped drop on-the-job injury and fatality rates.

- **Attacks on building trades workers.** They've come after the teachers, firefighters and other public servants. There are also plans in the works to repeal the Michigan Prevailing Wage Act and outlaw project labor agreements. Repealing those laws will surely result in less income for building trades workers.
